

3 DI boxes 5 vocal mics

2 condensor mics (1 on

short boom)

1 power source

1 XLR for wireless clip-on

1 guitar amp

1 bass amp

1 drum set: bass w/pedal, floor tom, cymbal stand, snare stand, high-hat stand

Band brings: cymbals, snare drum, Sarah's vocal mic (Shure 55), Sarah's accordion mic (right hand) *Accordion is the main instrument & should be loudest. Fiddle & guitar should be as loud during their rides.

*Sarah's lead vocals should be louder than other vocals, and on par with the accordion, not louder. *Acoustic guitar should be percussive, loud bass, low mids, zero highs, dry sound

A good start for monitors is an equal mix of accordion, fiddle, guitar, bass and vocals. Not too loud, please!
